Simply click it and follow the directions to add your story to the City of Memory! You will be asked to enter where the story takes place, a name for it, and some information about yourself. Then the site will check to make sure it's got the exact right location for your story - cool, huh? Then you'll be prompted to enter the story, a teaser, and any artistic credits or links. Finally you can upload a photograph along with your story (more extensive video and audio uploads will be available soon). It's really easy and intuitive. And your story will be available soon afterwards to share with friends and family!
